3. Learners are instructed to remit the examination fees **(Rs.900)** to GIFT before **20 April 2024**.
4. Candidates should take their places in the examination hall of the respective centre at least fifteen minutes before the commencement of the examination.

5. Candidates presenting themselves more than half an hour after the appointed time will not be admitted to the examination hall.
6. Candidates should bring with them their **Admission Letter** for inspection by the Supervisors of the respective Centre. **(Please take printout of the Admission Letter from the website)**
7. Candidates who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious disease will not be permitted.
8. Answer sheet will be supplied by the institute. Candidates are allowed to write the answers only on the answer sheets given by Gulati Institute of Finance and Taxation
9. Candidates should write their ARN (Admission Registration Number) in the space provided for the in the facing sheet of the answer book supplied by the institute. They are strictly prohibited from writing their names, ARN on any other page
10. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall till the expiry of at least half an hour after question paper has been given.
11. Candidates are prohibited from bringing into the examination room any book or portion of book, study materials, manuscript or paper of any description, mobile phones, lap top, iPad etc.
12. Candidates are allowed to use calculators for the examination.
13. Candidates are prohibited from communicating with or copying from each other and from communicating with any person outside the examination room.
14. When a candidate has finished writing his/her answers and wishes to return his/her answer books or at the end of the period prescribed for each particular part of the examination, he/she shall stand up in his/her place and remain standing until one of the supervisors has gone up to him/her and has received his/her answer book from him/her. He/she should not leave the hall, leaving the answer book in his/her seat
15. Any candidate acting in violation of these rules will be sent out the hall forthwith and will not be permitted to appear for the remaining papers of the examination. Violation of these rules may involve cancellation of the examination written by a candidate
