Concept

Data based decisions have acquired great significance in an era of volatility and complexity. One of the pivotal aspects of contemporary research is the outcome orientation for societal development. Policymakers and strategic thinkers look to researchers for employing authentic data analysis techniques, which help in predictive analysis based on historical data.

Econometrics, as a branch of Economics is concerned with the empirical estimation of economic relationships. It was developed for the quantitative analysis of theoretical inter-relations between economic variables. Econometrics is widely used by most disciplines as modern academic and corporate research necessitates quantification of inter-relations between the variables under investigation. Econometrics tests economic models through statistical trials. The results are then compared and contrasted against real-life examples.

The econometric methods and tools are instrumental in finding the stochastic relationship in a mathematical format. Econometric methods are used in multidisciplinary research involving business, commerce, engineering, physical sciences, biological sciences, medical sciences, geosciences and agricultural sciences. Thus, the present workshop is designed with a view to equipping the students, researchers and faculty members with the tools of econometric analysis.

In the first part of this work shop, participants are taken through all the necessary statistical techniques required for an understanding of the theory of Econometrics. This preliminary is followed by an exposition of the basics of Econometrics.

The Malabar Christian College (MCC), Kozhikode


